

Mediums – KTDA mediums met irregular support and ranged between USC8 easier to dearer by up to USC14. Plantation mediums varied between USC7 above previous rates to easier by up to USC8.

Lower Medium — Irregular varying between USC4 dearer to USC10 below last rates. Plainer — Easier by up to USC8

Secondary Grades (S1)

Offerings: 20,899 packages (1.11mkgs) — 21.47% unsold.

In the Secondary Catalogues, best BP's gained with others easier while PF's were saw irregular interest. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings held value with similar DUST's firm to about USC5 dearer. Other Fannings were steady with DUST's firm. BMF's were readily absorbed at last levels.

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Egyptian Packers lent steady support while Pakistan Packers, Yernen and other Middle Eastern countries reduced activity. Kazakhstan and other CIS states were more forceful on quality types while Bazaar and Afghanistan showed less interest. There was maintained but selective absorption from UK while Russia were less active. Sudan and South Sudan were absent.
